## FIRST GRADE SUPPLY LIST

- 2 Box (24) regular (#2) yellow pencils (good quality) (no names needed)
- 1 Zippered bag for school supplies (no boxes)
- \* 3 Box of crayons (<u>24</u> count) (Crayola is best)
- 1 Box of colored pencils (12 count)
- 1 Box of broad markers (10 count)
- \* 8 Glue sticks (no glue pens)
- \* 2 White block erasers
- 1 Pair of Fiskar scissors
- 1 Package of baby wipes
- 1 Package of Clorox wipes
- 2 <u>LARGE</u> boxes of tissues
- 1 Box of quart Ziploc bags (last names A-R)
- 1 Box of plastic spoons (last names A-R)
- 1 Box of gallon Ziploc bags (last names S-Z)
- 1 Box of plastic forks (last names S Z)
- 1 Change of clothing in a Ziploc bag just in case
